

Licensed Practical Nursing Scholarship

One \$800 Licensed Practical Nursing Scholarship will be awarded to a student for study in an approved Licensed Practical Nursing School.

This scholarship will be awarded one-half in the first semester and the remaining one-half in the second semester if the recipient remains enrolled and maintains a 2.5 GPA during the first semester.

To be eligible, the recipient must:

- A. Have been accepted for practical nurse training for at least one semester.
- B. Rank in the upper one-third of graduating class if completed high school within the last five years
- C. Reside in the area served by St. Francis Hospital & Health Services.

Registered Nurse Scholarship

One \$800 Registered Nurse Scholarship will be awarded to a student for study in approved school to obtain an associate or Bachelor's degree of nursing.

This scholarship will be awarded one-half in the first semester and the remaining one-half in the second semester if the recipient remains enrolled and maintains a 2.5 GPA during the first semester.

To be eligible, the recipient must:

- A. Have been accepted for training in an accredited institution.
- B. Rank in the upper one-third of graduating class if completed high school within the last five years.
- C. Reside in the area served by St. Francis Hospital & Health Services.

Medical Studies Scholarship

One \$800 Medical Studies Scholarship will be awarded to a student for study in approved school of healthcare curriculum such as medical school (physician), physical therapy, medical technology (laboratory), radiology (x-ray), medical terminology, etc.

This scholarship will be awarded one-half in the first semester and the remaining one-half in the second semester if the recipient remains enrolled and maintains a 2.5 GPA during the first semester.

To be eligible, the recipient must:

- A. Have been accepted for training in an accredited institution.
- B. Rank in the upper one-third of graduating class if completed high school within the last five years.
- C. Reside in the area served by St. Francis Hospital & Health Services.

Depending on the funds available, one of the above will be chosen as renewable.

Applications and references must be received prior to the deadline.

Recipients will be expected to provide to the designated representative of the St. Francis Hospital Auxiliary the name, address, and appropriate person so the funds can be forwarded to the institution. The recipient's school transcript must accompany the request for the second semester's payment if grade requirement is met.
